Important Notifications

Current COVID-19 advice for Family Day Care

- From Monday 12 July 2021 the Service NSW QR code will be mandatory for all early childhood education and care services.
- Education and care services are considered an essential service and may remain open, unless directed by NSW Health.
- In the 3 local government areas of Fairfield, Canterbury/
 Bankstown and Liverpool, parents are strongly encouraged to
 keep their children at home if they are able to do so, in order to
 limit movement in the community. If you have travelled outside
 these area, you must have a COVID19 test.
- Masks are required in early childhood education and care settings in the Greater Sydney region (including indoor and outdoor environments) per the latest public health order.
 Exemptions for wearing masks in ECE apply:
 - outside of the Greater Sydney region;
 - where a child is deaf or hard of hearing; or
 - the clear enunciation or visibility of the educator's mouth is essential.

Gap fee waivers


Even though child care services remain open in NSW, from 19 July 2021, services in Local Government Areas (LGAs) subject to stay-at-home orders can waive gap fees for parents on days they choose to keep their children at home.

Absences

Allowable absences reset on 1st July 2021 for the new financial year. This means that all children would have 42 allowable absences from this date.

Majority of the Educators should have received the 24 week Educational Program pack. If not, please contact the office to make arrangements. Please note that the staff will NOT attend to you if you arrive at the office without an appointment.
